2010 Chateau Haut-Bergey Blanc 90
Tasted at the Chateau Barde Haut in Saint Emilion. A blend of 80% Sauvignon Blanc and 20% Semillon raised in 50% new oak and the rest one-year old, the Haut-Bergey Blanc has a refined bouquet of lemon thyme and dried apricot that is well defined – the oak nicely integrated. The palate is medium-bodied with crisp acidity, hints of praline and passion fruit with a crisp, focused finish.

Pale straw. Clean floral nose offers hints of beeswax, white peach and gooseberry, complicated by passion fruit and melon. Bright and energetic on entry, with a strong lemony nuance to the gooseberry and peach flavors. Finishes long and clean, but with mounting, oak-derived tannins.
