The Garcin family has invested heavily in both money and time to resurrect a number of their estates, including Haut-Bergey (as well as Branon, Clos l'Eglise and Barde-Haut). The 2011 Haut-Bergey exhibits notes of charcoal embers, tobacco leaf, black currants, cherries, spice and earth. Made from a high dosage of Merlot combined with Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, it should age nicely for 10-15 years

The Haut-Bergey has a fresh blackcurrant and small dark cherry scented bouquet with fine delineation. The oak is well assimilated and it unfurls nicely in the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with a crisp entry and fine edgy tannins. At its core is a ball of rounded dark plum and cassis whilst the finish has fine delineation and intensity, it not the persistency of the previous two vintages. Tasted April 2012.
